### **Bibliodiversity**

the diversity of book publishing in terms of the variety of national, regional and disciplinary contexts, including culture, language (multilingualism), quality assurance standards, transparency, publishing traditions, rewards and incentive structures at universities (including royalties), and the publishing industry and its market mechanisms in general.



"No single model will fit all and there is no scenario for a perfect transition. Indeed, we do not expect all monographs to go OA, but we see a number of ways in which OA for books can be encouraged further."

Martin Paul Eve: "an initial issue of scalability [...]"

OPERAS Open Access Business Models White Paper (2018/2021) on the BPC model:

"Pros: Aids recognition of the costs involved in quality publishing.

Cons: Lack of funding available in AHSS, different levels of financial resource at different institutions makes for an uneven and unfair situation for academics, inefficient, high administrative burden for institutions and publishers, additional burden for academics."


